
# Who is Served by the KY-Moms MATR Program? A Snapshot of Pregnant Clients at Baseline

The KY-Moms MATR case management program is administered by the Division of Substance Use Disorder in the Department for Behavioral Health, Developmental and Intellectual Disabilities; KY-Moms MATR (502) 782-6192

This fact sheet summarizes characteristics reported by 68 pregnant women in the KY-Moms MATR program who completed a pre-birth baseline assessment between June 2021 and October 2022.


49% Met study criteria for generalized anxiety
