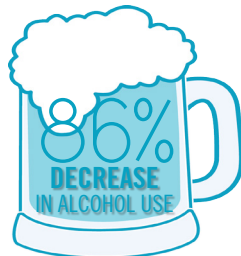
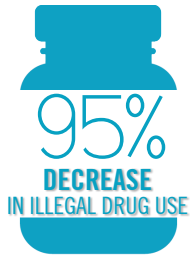


Positive Outcomes for Recovery Kentucky Clients

RECOVERY CENTER OUTCOME STUDY FACT SHEET - JANUARY 2014

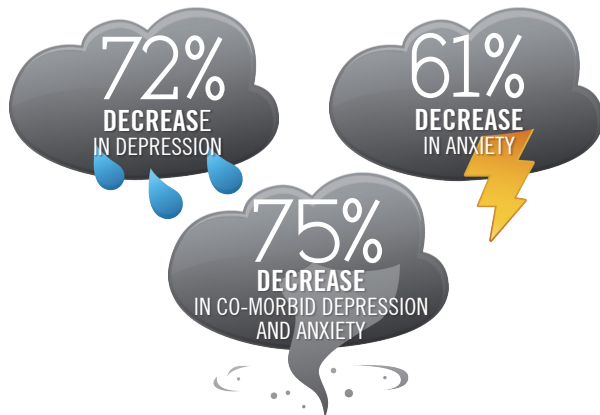
Recovery Kentucky centers help people recover from addiction, gain control over their lives, and transition to permanent housing.

Decrease in percentage of adults who reported any past 30 day substance use*

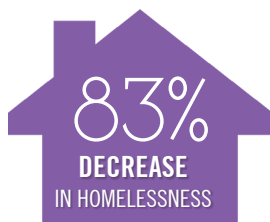


*After Phase 1 of the program

Improved recovery supports



Clients rated their experience with the Recovery Kentucky Program as 8.3 out of 10



The majority of individuals (75%) gave a highly positive rating between 8 and 10 of their experience in the program, where 10 represented the best possible experience.

Recovery Kentucky saves state taxpayers money



Using national estimates of the cost of substance abuse and applying them to clients' substance use before and after program participation, there was a \$3.59 return in cost savings for every dollar spent on providing recovery services.
