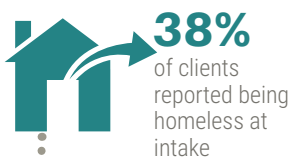
RECOVERY CENTER OUTCOME STUDY FACT SHEET - JANUARY 2017

Recovery Kentucky was created to help Kentuckians recover from substance abuse, which often leads to chronic homelessness. Fourteen of the currently established Recovery Kentucky programs<sup>1</sup> participated in the Recovery Center Outcome Study between July 2014 and June 2015.

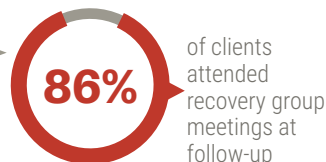
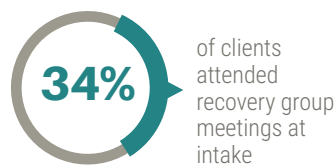
## SIGNIFICANT REDUCTIONS IN PAST-6-MONTH SUBSTANCE USE



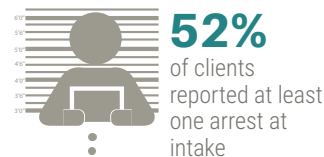
### DECREASES IN CURRENT HOMELESSNESS

Using national estimates of the cost of substance abuse and applying them to clients' substance use before and after program participation, there was an estimated \$2.71 return in avoided costs for every dollar invested in providing recovery services.
