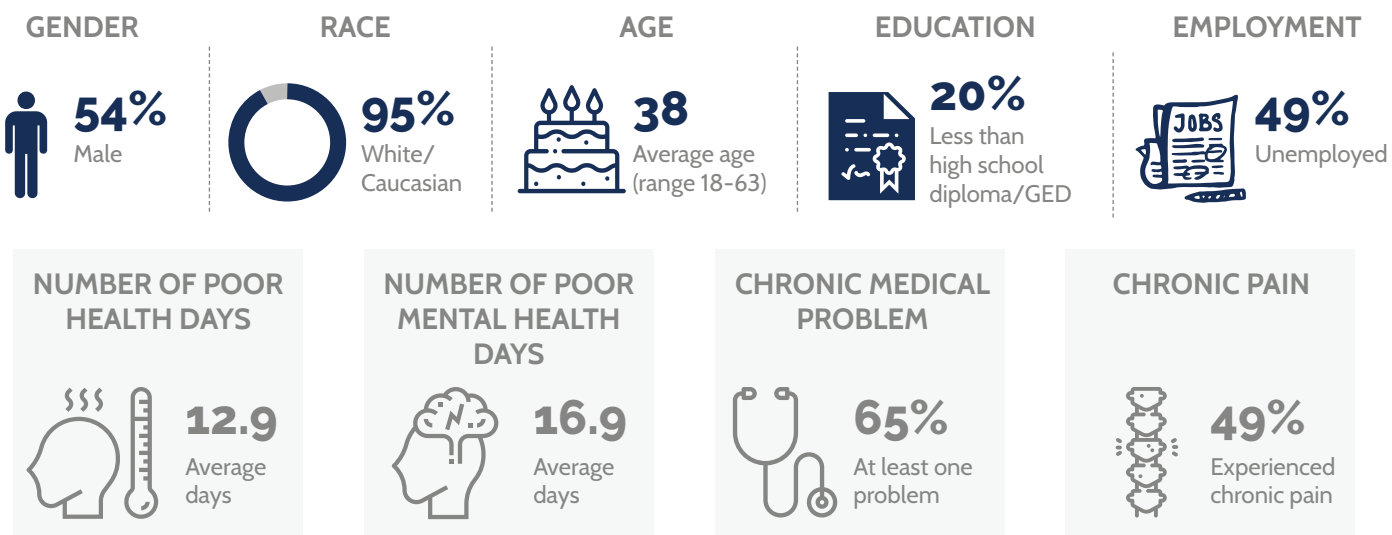


Kentucky Opioid Treatment Clients at Intake

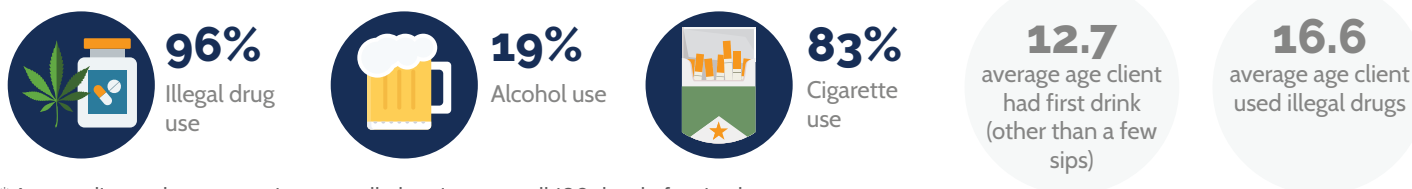
KENTUCKY OPIOID REPLACEMENT TREATMENT PROGRAM OUTCOME STUDY INTAKE FACT SHEET - 2020

This fact sheet summarizes characteristics reported by 384 clients who participated in the Kentucky Opioid Replacement Treatment Outcome Study and completed an intake assessment between January 2018 and December 2018.



Risk Factors at Intake

SUBSTANCE USE 6 MONTHS BEFORE PROGRAM ENTRY*



* Among clients who were not in a controlled environment all 180 days before intake

MENTAL HEALTH 6 MONTHS BEFORE PROGRAM ENTRY

¹ In earlier versions of the instrument, individuals who reported no to all victimization questions were not asked the PTSD symptom items; thus, 263 individuals had PTSD scores at intake. A score of 10 or higher is indicative of clinically significant PTSD symptomatology.
