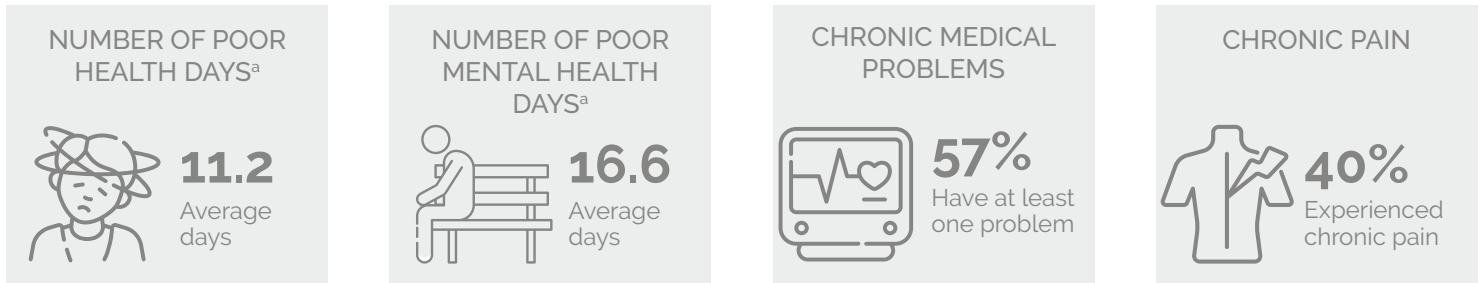
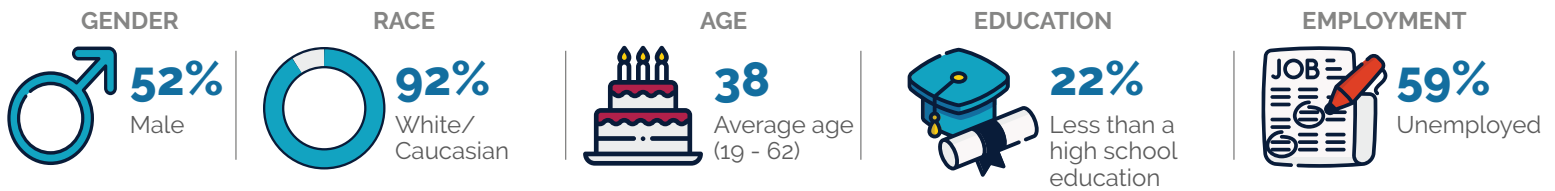


# Kentucky Opioid Treatment Clients at Intake

KENTUCKY OPIOID REPLACEMENT TREATMENT PROGRAM OUTCOME STUDY INTAKE FACT SHEET - 2024

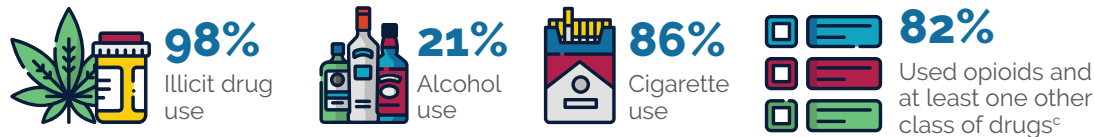
