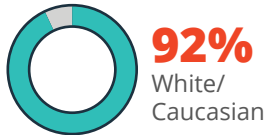

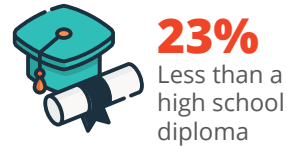

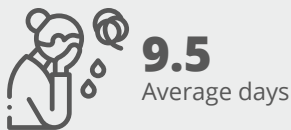

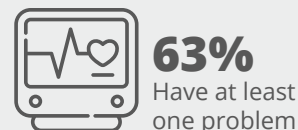
NUMBER OF POOR HEALTH DAYS^a

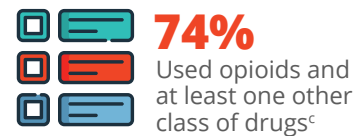

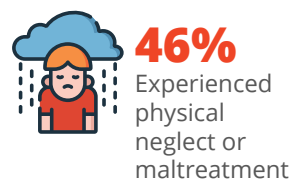
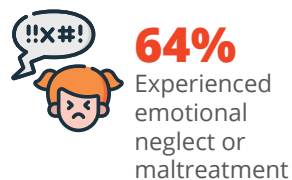
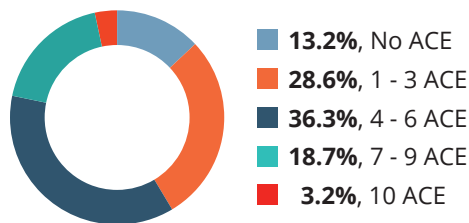
SUBSTANCE USE IN THE 6 MONTHS BEFORE PROGRAM ENTRY^b



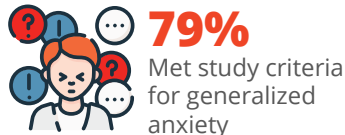
