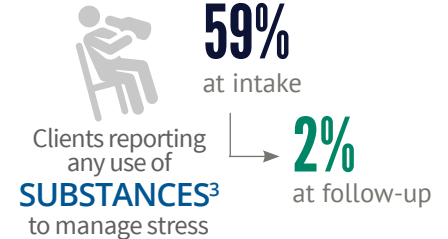
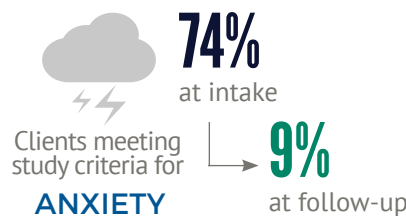
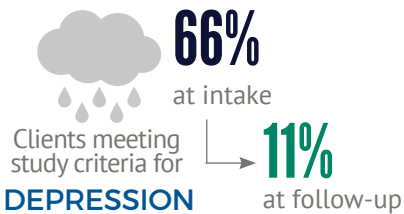
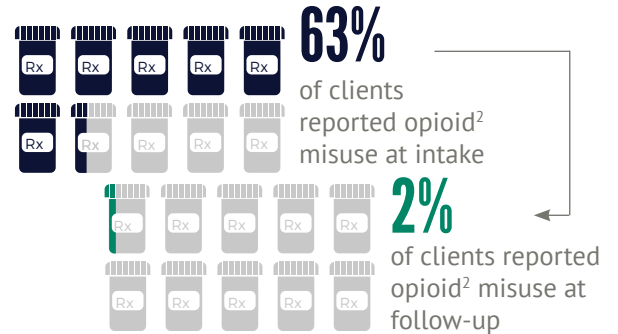
Recovery Kentucky was created to help Kentuckians recover from substance abuse, which often leads to chronic homelessness. Fifteen of the currently established Recovery Kentucky programs¹ participated in the Recovery Center Outcome Study between July 2015 and June 2016 and 12-month follow-up survey between July 2016 and June 2017.

SIGNIFICANT REDUCTIONS IN PAST-6-MONTH SUBSTANCE USE AND MENTAL HEALTH PROBLEMS

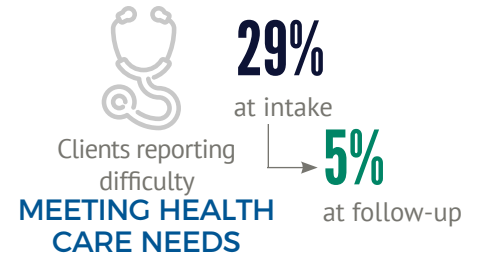
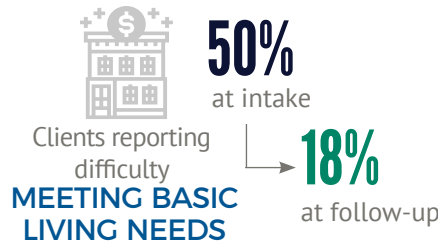
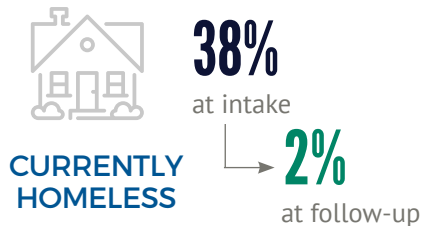
ANY ILLEGAL DRUG USE

Using national estimates of the cost of substance abuse and applying them to clients' substance use before and after program participation, there was an estimated \$2.60 return in avoided costs for every dollar invested in providing recovery services.

² Misuse of opioids other than heroin, including prescription opiates, methadone, and buprenorphine.

³ Includes alcohol, prescription drugs, and illegal drugs.
