

Web-based Kentucky DUI Assessment Instrument (KDAI)

Minimum System Requirements

The following Minimum Requirements have been compiled for your reference. Please contact the Kentucky DUI Project (see below) if you have other questions.

What are the minimum computer hardware requirements?

All computers connecting to the web-based KDAI should have at least a Pentium 3 or comparable processor and at least 256MB of RAM. This information can be found by clicking on “My Computer” and then “View System Information” on a PC or by clicking “About this Mac” under the Apple menu on a Mac.

What are the minimum operating system requirements?

All computers connecting to the web-based KDAI should be running Microsoft Windows XP, Vista, or Windows 7. Mac users will be able to use the system with a current version of Mac OS.

What are the Internet requirements?

Any computer at your DUI assessment program that needs to access the web-based KDAI must have an Internet connection.

Can I use any web browser?

The website has been developed for use with Internet Explorer 9, but has been tested successfully with other common, widely-used web browsers such as Mozilla Firefox, Google Chrome & Safari.

What other software will be required?

Adobe Reader is needed to view reports (e.g., enrollment form) generated by the web-based KDAI. This free software can be downloaded from: <http://get.adobe.com/reader/>

What other software is suggested?

It is suggested that computers have antivirus and antispyware programs installed. There are many free versions of this type of software at <http://download.cnet.com>. It is also suggested that you stay current with available operating system updates and patches.

How will I be trained on the new system?

Trainings will be conducted online through web conferencing software (Adobe Connect). Trainees will not have to install any software on their computer in order to participate in the training. To connect to a web conference, you will need an Internet connection and audio connection either through your computer or phone. A web conference invitation will be emailed to trainees in advance. At the time of the training, you will need to click the link in the e-mail and follow the directions. Training sessions will be available to accommodate a variety of work schedules (days, nights, and weekends) and last an hour and a half. Detailed instructions will be provided in advance.

How will I register to use the new system?

Certified program administrators and assessors affiliated with a licensed and certified DUI assessment program wishing to access the web-based KDAI must be approved by the Division of Behavioral Health and have an active email address. Your email address will be used to register you in the system and to send you information about your user account.
